

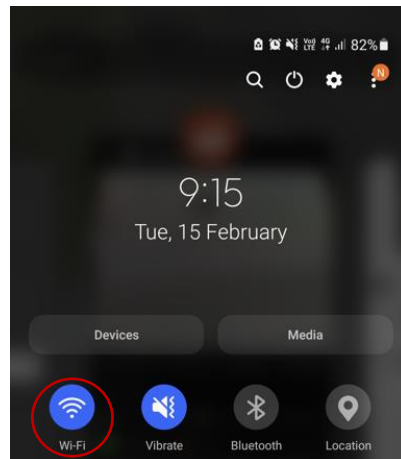
How to connect to Eduroam in Android

Introduction

EduRoam is an agreement between a list of educational institutions to share access to their wireless networks. Being part of the EduRoam federation allows Queensland Museum Network Staff and students from other institutions who are visiting the Museums to connect to the EduRoam Wi-Fi network.

This guide will help show you how to connect to EduRoam network on an Android Platform.

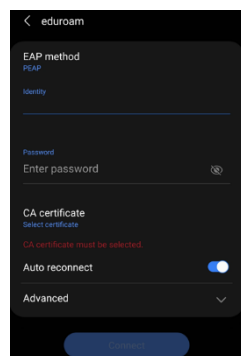
1. Swipe down from the top of the screen of your android device and select the Wi-fi symbol.



2. Select eduroam in the list of available networks in your device.



3. Use your institution credentials (your email address in the identity section and password) to log in. On the CA certificate section, select the drop down list and select Don't validate. Press Connect afterwards.



4. You successfully connected your Android device to the eduroam network.
